Policy Title: TOBACCO FREE FACILITIES

Mid-State Technical College is committed to providing a healthy environment for all students, employees, members of the community, and the general public who utilize college property including buildings, grounds, and vehicles. The College complies with the statewide smoking ban and prohibits smoking except in designated smoking shelters at each location. This policy also applies to electronic cigarettes.

No person shall be allowed to use tobacco products in any facility or vehicle owned by the College. Benches, lighting, and receptacles for extinguishing smoking materials are made available in the shelters, along with signage that states "no smoking beyond this point except at the shelters".

All members of the campus community are responsible for helping to enforce this policy and anyone who observes a violation is asked to make the violator aware of the restriction contained in this policy.

All sales and advertising of tobacco products at college locations are prohibited.

This policy applies to all students, employees, and visitors of the College.
