- If students satisfy the world language requirement by transferring in a full year of high school world language credits with a "C" or better, then they may need additional elective credits to satisfy the program credit requirement.
- Courses in the Diversity/Ethnic studies category may apply to the Humanities and/or the Social Science categories.
- Courses in the Global Studies & Languages category may apply to the Humanities and/or Social Science categories.
