

ATTENTION: All students are expected to maintain and promote the highest standards of personal honesty and integrity. These standards apply to all examinations.... If there is a suspicion that exam integrity has been compromised, test scores will be cancelled.

Materials other than the test, pencil, and scratch paper provided by testing staff are not allowed in the testing room unless permission is provided by testing, instructional, or disability service staff.

Prohibited items include:

- Purses, tote bags, backpacks, jackets, coats, hats
- Calculators, cell phones, pagers, portable music players, other electronic equipment
- Textbooks, dictionaries, notebooks, notes, formula sheets, other materials
- Food or beverages when using a computer (if not using a computer, beverages must have a cover/lid)
- Other nonessential items

You may not open any computer programs or visit any Internet sites during a testing session aside from those required for test completion.

The testing room may be under video surveillance while you are testing. Any activity that is not permitted will be reported to appropriate staff.
