



## General Education Transfer Guide Mid-State Technical College – Liberal Arts to the University of Wisconsin-Stout

**University Requirements:** UW-Stout prepares students to graduate with broad, complex understandings of daily life in a global society. Thus, there are four university requirements to be fulfilled prior to graduation: 1.) Racial and Ethnic Studies (RES) 2.) Global Perspectives (GLP), and 3.) Stout Core/General Education (GE, divided into categories and areas), and 4.) Major Studies. Students who select courses that count for more than one of the above requirements (two total: 1 within either GE or Major Studies, and 1 within either RES or GLP) reduce the total number of courses they must take to fulfill university requirements.

Students who have successfully completed the Associate of Arts (AA) or Transfer Associate of Science-Liberal Arts (AS) degree will have Stout Core/General Education, Racial & Ethnic Studies, and Global Perspectives considered complete with the exception of any course specifically required by the major. Check the undergraduate bulletin for what majors require specific coursework within Stout Core/GE.
