1. Transfer Institution: Mid-State Technical College

2. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh
 Degree: Bachelor of Science
 Program: Human Services Leadership

3. Rationale: This agreement is being established in order to expand educational opportunities for graduates of Mid-State Technical College and to strengthen the educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS).

In addition to the courses listed in the table above, a block of transfer credits will be awarded at admission into the Human Services Leadership major for completion of one of the Mid-State Technical College programs listed in #1 above. 5. Credits from Mid-State Technical College to transfer to UW Oshkosh: See attachments.
6. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements that the student must satisfy:
 - Earn at least 120 credits.
 - Earn a cumulative GPA in General Education courses of 2.00 or higher.
 - Earn an overall cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
 - Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
 - Earn at least 15 of the last 30 credits from UW Oshkosh.
 - Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
 - Earn at least 42 credits in 300/400 level courses.

Conditions:

- The terms of this agreement apply only for the purposes of entry into the Bachelor of Science degree in Human Services Leadership at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree and/or major other than the Bachelor of Science degree in Human Services Leadership will find that the extended transfer of credit does not apply outside of this program.
- Students from the above-mentioned Wisconsin Technical College must have successfully completed one of the Associate of Applied Science programs listed in #1 above (fulfilling all coursework stipulated therein) with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5/4.00 for consideration for transfer under the terms of this agreement. The terms of the agreement do **not** apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for the Associate degree.

7. Effective date: December 1, 2017

8. Review date: This agreement will be reviewed in June 2019 and updated or extended at that time.
