Ground rules regarding public comment on Board agenda item(s): 1. Public comments must pertain to an agenda item. 2. No person may speak more than once to an issue or for a period longer than three to five minutes. 3. No more than three people may be heard to one side of an

issue. 4. The District Board reserves the right to limit the total amount of time during which public comments will be heard at any given meeting. 5. The Board Chairperson reserves the right to stop unprofessional discussion or discussion targeted toward a specific individual. Deviation from these parameters may occur upon the consent of the majority of the Board.

E. Closed Session

The Presidential Search Phone Screen Committee will convene to closed session immediately following the open session to discuss employment strategies related to the presidential search and conduct candidate screenings. This closed session is being held in compliance with Chapter 19, Subchapter 19.85(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The Board Committee may or may not reconvene to open session and may take action on items discussed in closed session.
