Pearson VUE: Acceptable Forms of Identification

Identification requirements vary by exam sponsor. When you register for your test, you will receive an email/letter from Pearson VUE explaining ID requirements. Read this letter carefully. You must meet the identification requirements in order to test. *You will not be allowed to test if you do not meet the exam sponsor's identification requirements.*

Candidates often must present two forms of personal identification. The primary ID must include both a permanent picture and a signature and must not be expired. The secondary ID must include a signature and must not be expired. Common acceptable forms of identification as recognized by Pearson VUE include:

Primary Identification:

- Driver's License, Learner's Permit, or State ID Card
- Passport
- Military ID
- Employee ID, School ID, or Credit Card (only if it contains both a photo and signature and is not expired)

Secondary identification:

- Social Security Card
- Debit/ATM Card
- Credit Cards
- A second form of ID from the Primary list

Again, Pearson VUE prohibits us from allowing you to test if you do not meet the sponsor's identification requirements.
