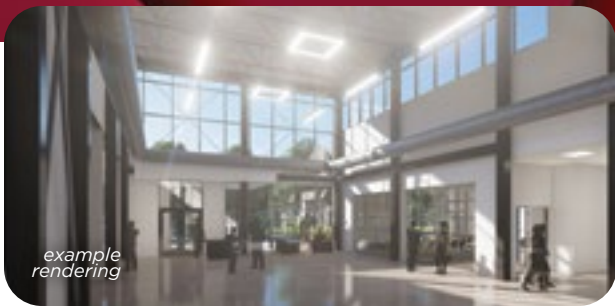


**ABOUT MID-STATE**
