PARKING POLICY & REGULATIONS

Mid-State Technical College (MSTC) strives to provide a safe, accessible, and a well-maintained parking environment for all students, employees, and visitors.

The following guidelines outline the expectations and procedures that support MSTC's parking policy:

1. Parking is reserved for MSTC students, staff, and visitors during regular hours of operation. All others, or those needing to park outside regular hours, must receive prior authorization. Overnight parking is permitted by authorization only. For approval, contact Campus Security at 715-422-5656.
2. Park in designated stalls only. Stalls are clearly marked and are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
3. Do not park in driveway areas or along curbs. Roadways and entrances must be kept open for emergencies.
4. Individuals parking in a restricted area or illegally may be ticketed by the local police department. Vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense.
5. Any vehicles in the lot that obstruct maintenance (including snow plowing), obviously not operable, and/or not operated for days may be towed at owner's expense.
6. There will be no unauthorized parking in courtyards.

MSTC is not responsible or liable for any damage that may occur to vehicles when parked on MSTC property.
